


LOZ: LINK IN HOLBERINA INSTRUCTION MANUAL!!!😊



This is a guide about my Zelda fan game, The Legend of Zelda Link in Holberina! I started it when I was 9 and a half years old. I just turned 10.

Here is the story line.

After Link struggled to save Holdrum and Labrynnna the triforme took link back to Hyrule. It said that Zelda had been taken to the land in between where Holdrum and Labrynnna touch. The land of Holberina! Link wondered how Gannon could still be alive after his fierce battle with Link. How could he

live without Koume and Kotake, the evil witches? The triforme said an evil wizard appeared and revived him. Who is the wizard? What will happen to Link? Find out in my fan-game...

Tips and Secrets: (spoilers ahead)

Make sure that you look for secret doors in all of the dungeons...

The rock wall by the Harp of ages is bombed with the Super Bombs. The dungeon inside is a later dungeon. This is the order of levels

1: The cave by the falling rocks.

2: Head right and get the harp of ages. From the first dungeon head right x2 screens. Play the harp on the ground symbol.

2: Head up for secret dungeon, or right for dungeon 2. Play the harp on the symbol.

3: One screen to the right. Play the harp on the symbol. There are two here.

4: The cave by the Harp of ages See tip #2.

5: From HoA (harp of ages) head down, left x2, and up.

Head two screens down from Maku Tree.

VAATI GUIDE!!!

Secret boss Vaati is a bruiser! Here is the order to attack him.
You must beat Gannon BEFORE Vaati!!!!!!

Sword to eye

Golden seed to eye

Left claw x4

Right claw

Sword to eye

Left claw

Right claw

Left claw x2

Sword to eye

Hit human Vaati with sword

you want. FIND IT YOURSELF!!!
